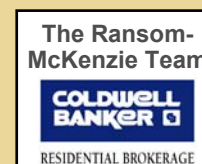

ABOUT OUR HONOREES:



Connie Ransom: As chair of the CUC from 2008-2010, Connie led the public advocacy campaign to fund the UCR School of Medicine. A long-time champion of the arts in Riverside, she and husband Roger ran the Art Works gallery for ten years. Connie is president of the Sam and Alfreda Maloof Foundation.



Kathy Allavie: One of Riverside's most prolific volunteers, RUSD School Board member Kathy Allavie has a long history of supporting public art, most notably the giant orange and art float projects. Kathy and her husband John, recently launched a Scholarship to support a pipeline for UCR students to teach STEM subjects in RUSD schools.



Fortino Morales is one of the faces of Riverside's local farming movement. As a UCR student ten years ago, he led the creation of UCR's first community garden.
